Maybe you're exploring Toddler ministry for your context?


Did you know research by <u>ComRes</u> asked practising Christians what age they came to faith, with the results showing 40% before the age of 5 and <u>Talking</u> <u>Toddlers</u> research stated that 74% of all parents with children under the age of five have attended a church activity in the previous 12 months?

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


Networking

Difference for Young People

Last month, I was privileged to be invited to Lambeth Palace to the launch of the Difference Course for Young People.

We explored the three habits at the core of "Difference"

Be curious, Be present, Reimagine, through collaborative artwork, held penalty shoot-outs and prayed about division through a labyrinth.

Young people shared the issues that concern them, their experiences of the course and questioned Archbishop Welby, challenging him to bring both young and old together.

There was the opportunity to explore the course materials and pray for a generation of peacemakers.

Difference is a free resource that "equips young people with skills to cross divides, navigate disagreement, practise forgiveness and pursue a just and flourishing world as they seek to follow Jesus."

There are currently courses for Youth Groups and Secondary Schools, with the Primary School course launching in January 2025.



"Bible Buds is a fun packed resource for Toddler and Pre-School Groups.



Questions from 16-19 year olds

"Based on her own experience of working in a local Sixth Form College, Lahna Pottle, 16-19s Specialist at SchoolsworkUK, has created a 6 week session plan tackling 6 key questions that 16-19 year olds want to talk about.

The aim of this resource is to open up discussion, encourage listening, and support the students' exploration of faith and worldviews. The key is exploring why they feel or think they way they do, and explore their own influences, bias and beliefs."


