
We are running the course in Lincoln Diocese, with content being delivered online, at a three-day conference, and locally.



"Start to Stir"

Resources to help people share their faith and a course designed to help stir spiritual curiosity amongst young people.

"The Stir Course is a set of interactive sessions designed to use in your outreach context.

It helps people to discover their soul through experience... ...then introduces them to God and the person of Jesus before offering an

invitation to make a faith commitment.

Each session can run from 20-60 minutes and uses experiences, video clips and reflection to stir up the many spiritual emotions, questions and longings that lie dormant, under the surface of most people's lives."



"Unfold is a Bible study for young people aged 11 to 17. It's especially suited to groups of less than 8 and where the young people may not all the same age or stage of Christian commitment. You can do an Unfold session together it in as little as 30 minutes or take longer if you have more time. Young people can write, colour and interact with Unfold so each study is designed to be used once. Unfold comes in packs of five studies each one looking at a different encounter with Jesus from the gospels.

Series 2 and 3 are underway and will be published through the Autumn 2024

Research



<u>"Influencers: peer evangelism amongst young</u> <u>people in the UK"</u>

This research spoke to UK based Christian young people and youth leaders regarding the methods and perceived effectiveness of peer to peer evangelism and outreach amongst teenagers.

The research, which was the result of a partnership between us Youth for Christ, HOPE Together, Alpha, Church Army, Church of England, Scripture Union, and Youthscape, offers several key findings that we believe provide significant challenge and insight into our current models for evangelism and some of the best ways the UK church can seek to empower young people to share their faith.

A third (34%) of young Christians told us they share their faith regularly"



Hybrid Mission with the 95 - Join the conversation!

Join Scripture Union as they unpack their new research report. Spearheaded by Sarah Davison, in partnership with Liverpool Hope University the research looks at how young people connect in online and offline spaces and what that looks like when exploring faith.
